

# GLOBAL AI LAWS - OVERVIEW

June 2024

The global regulatory framework is evolving at speed. This is a snapshot of the position as of June 2024.

## UK

- AI (Regulation) Bill (Private Members' Bill) (not proceeding due to the general election but due to be reintroduced following this)
- The current government position published in January 2024
- The government response to white paper published in January 2024 indicates that the government does not intend to introduce legislation to regulate AI at this time, but expects regulators to regulate AI use via existing laws, including the UK GDPR.
- The main opposition party has stated that if it is successful in the general election it will introduce binding regulation on the companies developing the most powerful AI models.

## EU

- EU AI Act (expected to be in force soon)
- AI Liability Directive (in draft)
- Existing laws, including the Data Act, apply

- Executive Order on the Safe, Secure and Trustworthy Development and Use of Artificial Intelligence (adopted)
- Drafts of multiple further AI-related laws have been proposed

- 40+ draft laws across 20+ states

- Draft of Law No. 31814 on the promotion of artificial intelligence in favor of the country's economic and social development (in draft)

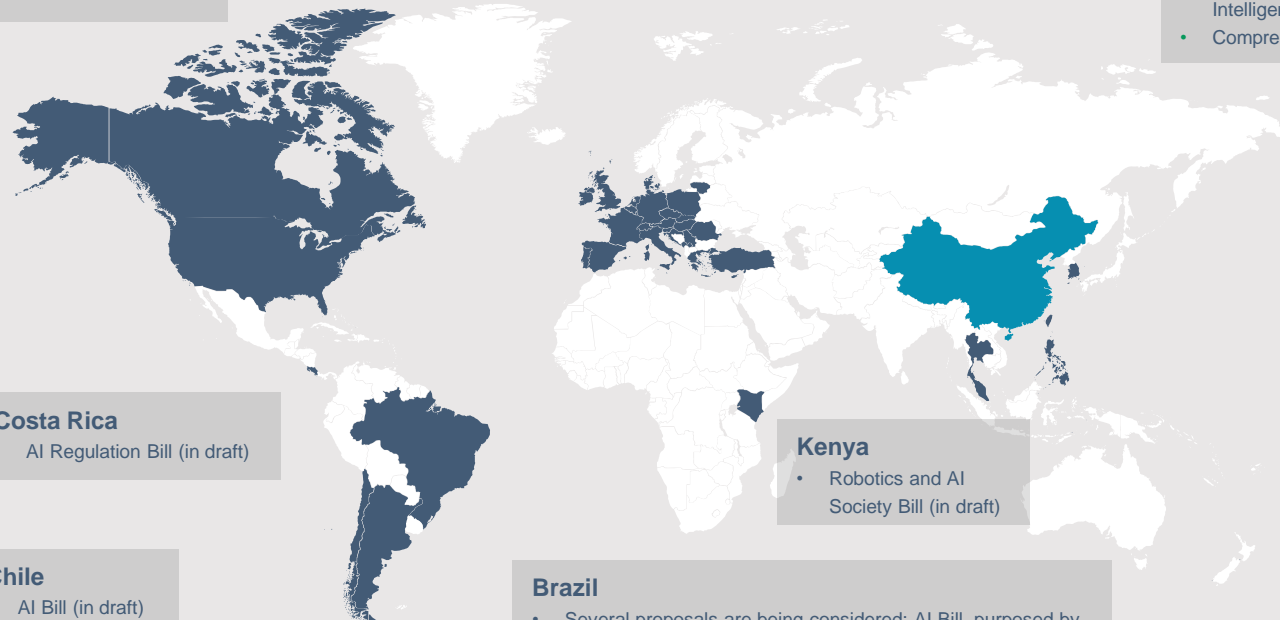
- Various drafts of an AI Act have been proposed
