There are now more than 1 million plug-in vehicles on the streets in Europe



The UK Government have announced a new £400 Million EV Charging Infrastructure Investment Fund (CIIF) to accelerate the roll-out of charging infrastructure from spring 2019.

Clean Air strategy: aim to end the sale of new conventional petrol and diesel cars and vans by 2040.

### Recognising the EV Infrastructure Demand



17,000 public chargepoints (including 1,300 rapid chargers) across UK



Providing £500 off installation costs of charging sockets at workplaces with a further £4.2 million commitment to see over 8000 sockets installed before end of March 2019



### **Investing £4.5 million** in the On-Street Residential Chargepoint Scheme until 2020

Ultra-low emission taxi infrastructure scheme offering a minimum of £6 million to local authorities

### UK Electric Bus Deployment:



- The UK has the largest number of electric buses with over 18% of the total European fleet
- A further £48 million available to Local Authorities for ultra-low emission buses and the infrastructure to support them
- The Scottish Government have also announced it will accelerate the procurement of ultra-low emission bus fleet by the early 2030s

The UK Government is currently working with 62 cities and local authorities to develop local Air Quality Plans and Clean Air Zones.
